



PROTECT THE RAINFOREST

For example weekly patrols by trained rangers and regular reporting.



PREVENTING
RELEASE OF CO2

Every tree that is not felled prevents the release of CO2.

RESCUE/ RELEASE ENDANGERED ANIMALS

We finance and maintain a Wildlife Rescue
Centre and pay the monthly salary of a qualified vet.



EMPOWERING LOCAL DAYAK

We support scholarship programmes, introduce waste disposal in the villages and provide health education.

Meroq is part of Sangkulirang Mangkalihat where 54 licenses have been granted to palm oil companies, coal mining and cement mines.

Protecting endangered animals like Pangolins, critically endangered. Bornean Orang Utan, threatened with extinction. Kelawat Gibbon, threatened with extinction too.

PREVENTION OF THE FOREST ECO-SYSTEM IN EAST-KALIMANTAN

LONG SAM aims to improve the economy of surrounding villages, struggling with declining economies due to stagnant tourism income and comparisons to neighboring villages for prosperity.

Numer.ous species depend on the biodiversity of primary oldgrowth rainforest like Meroq but the people living there need to safe their daily needs first.
